


I know that many of you have cottages that you head to and I pray that your summer at your home away from home offers you as much variety and joy as we in the city.

I tell the tale of Where you have been,


Where you are going and

This is a group for folks who have lost a loved one in their life and would like to share time with others in that journey. They meet the last Friday of every month at FHUC in the Fireside Room.




